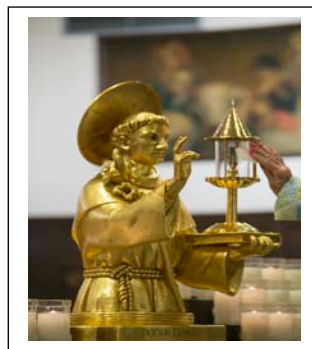


Saint Anthony's Relics Visit Massachusetts from 8/22 to 9/1.
